Fitting Instructions

You will need an adjustable wrench to fit. We also recommend an old cloth to dry the radiator tapping.

1 Switch the central heating system off and allow to cool

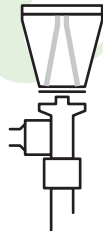
2 Isolate the radiator

Avoid flooding by closing the isolator valves at the bottom of the radiator – at one end this will be a lockshield valve with a plastic cover – remove the cover and turn the spindle clockwise using the adjustable wrench.

At the other end will either be a wheelhead valve, which can be turned off by hand, or a thermostatic valve which should be turned to '0'.

3 Select the Micro Adaptor (see pictures below)

Two adaptors are supplied with the Micro to fit a total of five different radiator thread sizes. Where possible, replace the plug (which the little square vent pin fits in to) rather than the pin itself. The 5mm adaptor uses the rubber washer.

4 Remove old vent pin using radiator key & fit adaptor

Mop up any spillage with cloth. Match the adaptor against the thread of the pin you removed, screw adaptor in by hand, then the last nip using wrench.

5 Fit the Micro Cartridge and turn radiator valves back on
